To whom it may concern:

As a designated "large" elementary charter school on Vandenberg Space Force Base, we provide TK-6 educational programs for active-duty service member families as well as individuals serving in the National Guard and Reserves who also have school-age children.

Manzanita Public Charter School is keenly aware that military-connected students must move whenever their active-duty parent/guardian receives a permanent change of station relocation order. These required relocations mean that a military-connected child can expect to change schools between six to nine times more often than non-military-connected children. As a result, military-connected children often face unique academic and social emotional challenges and struggle to stay on track to be college and career ready.

Adopting The California Purple Star School Designation Program's metrics at MPCS continues to allow our team to help reduce the burden on military-connected students and their families by more clearly articulating the most critical transition supports for military-connected students and their families. The Purple Star program, for Manzanita Public Charter School, would be a way to celebrate, publicly, our deep commitment to meeting these requirements. Being designated a CA Purple Star School would also signal that MPCS is equipped to support military-connected students and their families' unique needs.

Our LEA's vision statement includes the following: "MPCS is a caring, public charter school which offers high rigor, achievement, and support coupled with personalized services." It is my belief, that each day, our school strongly lives this vision. Therefore, this application process, which defines a more 'personalized' support for our military-connected students,' is in alignment with the LEA's core values.

I am wholeheartedly an advocate of this application process and effort.

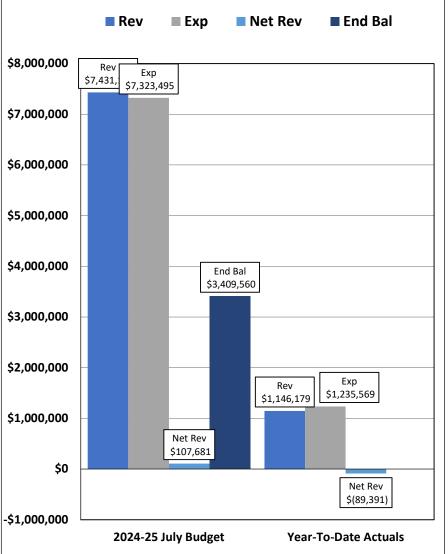
